

## Sher Le Mon 2020 Season rules (V1Ph3)

Please note these are the rules based on the guidelines we have for Phase 3. As the summer goes on they may change, and we expect if things continue to progress in the state they will change. If so you will be made aware as quickly as we can via signs at the club, email blast or printed versions distributed at club.

### RULE CHANGES

1. Initially no guests will be allowed. (due to capacity restrictions we must follow)
2. Initially children 13 and under will not be allowed at the club without adult supervision. The supervising individual may be any adult member. The only exception is during swim team practice as the children are supervised by the coaching staff. (necessary to assist with monitoring/management/reminders of the 6ft separation requirement and mask use)
3. Game room will be open; nothing can be borrowed from "lost and found" (goggles, dive toys, etc); games and playground balls will not be available from the front desk. Kidde pool toys may not be left at the pool. For all mentioned above, you must bring your own, no sharing with individuals outside your family and everything must be taken with you when you leave for the day.
4. We will not be issuing membership cards this year but we will be assigning membership numbers.
5. No parties of any kind will be allowed.
6. You can be paged when food deliveries arrive but you must conduct the payment transaction outside the building away from the front door.

### CAPACITY

1. The state has provided a formula to use to determine facility capacity. They have adjusted/refined it with every phase. Based on previous year club use we feel the Phase 3 formula allows us to open without implementing a reservation system. That could change at any time but are hopeful that everyone is considerate of others and there will not be a need.
2. Should it be necessary, we have been discussing methods to allow one to check the count of individuals at the club so you could check before you arrived. We'll share more on that when appropriate.

### ENTERANCE TO THE CLUB

1. We are required to track every individual who is at the club and also required to perform a COVID screening for every individual. Initially in an effort to simplify the process for staff when members arrive, you will need to complete a **new** SLM COVID Screening Sheet and turn it in every time any 1 or more individuals from your membership comes to the club. It can be completed ahead of your arrival if you wish.
  - a. We request you to legibly print your name, your membership #, your phone # and the names of the individuals on your membership who are "entering" at that time.
  - b. Don't list all individuals on your membership on the form, only those entering at that time.

- c. The form contains the COVID questions which you need to answer. One set of questions applies to all persons listed on the sheet.
- d. Each form must be signed by an adult listed on the membership (guardian, if applicable). Form must be dated.
- e. There will be forms at the club if you forget to bring one already completed.
- f. Please note at this point **you will not be allowed in the club unless you turn in a form.** One form per day will cover and individual but if you leave the club and then return you will be asked if you have any change in the previous replies for Symptoms and Risk Factors.

#### WHILE IN THE CLUB

- 1. Everyone is required to maintain 6ft separation at all times everywhere in the facility.
- 2. You are required to wear your mask if you are moving around the facility. Provided there is appropriate distancing you do not have to have your mask on if you are sitting in a chair.
- 3. No one should be wearing a mask if swimming in the pool.
- 4. If you are observed repeatedly ignoring items 1 and 2 after being reminded, you may be asked to leave the facility for the day. If it occurs over multiple days the individual may be removed from the membership or the entire membership may be revoked. We know that will not be necessary but feel it is important to make very clear in this time.
- 5. Men's and ladies showers and bathrooms will be open but changing rooms will not be.
- 6. The playground will not be closed and you may use at your own risk. It is not feasible for that to be disinfected effectively because of its size and many surfaces that would be considered high touch.
- 7. Barbeque grills will be available for use. You must supply your own cooking utensils and maintain the appropriate separation while in use.

#### OUR ROUTINES

- 1. The Men's and Ladies bathroom will be disinfected at an appropriate interval based on the number of individuals in the facility.
- 2. We are required to disinfect chairs after use so will ask for your assistance in helping by turning your lounge chair on its side before you leave. If you happen to use a straight back chair you can just turn it so it faces away from the pool. That will help us quickly locate those which need cleaning so they can be used again.
- 3. We don't anticipate needing to check everyone's temperature as they enter but are prepared to do so if we determine it is required and would be using a no contact thermometer.
- 4. Periodic announcements will be made to remind everyone in the facility about maintaining separation and mask wear.

#### WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP ?

- 1. Most importantly follow all rules **ALWAYS**. That will allow the staff to do everything they need to do.
- 2. The chairs are placed at the required 6 ft distance and have also been grouped with 4 together in places. Please leave the groups of 4 for parties of 3 or more to help manage distancing. If

additional chairs are needed for your group they may be moved but cannot be placed where distancing rules would not be adhered to.

3. Be considerate of other members. We have all heard that the cloth mask worn by many people does not protect them from getting the virus but rather helps stop the spread. Please be part of the solution to stop any further spread.

We are sharing this information so you can decide if you want a membership in 2020 under the conditions noted. Any refund request received once the facility is open will be reviewed to decide what action will be taken.

The application you sign/signed contains a waiver. Please read it. You will also be asked to sign a COVID-19 specific waiver shortly. Should you decide you don't want to sign the COVID-19 specific waiver you will be refunded in full, any monies you have paid and you will no longer have a membership for 2020.
